

Want to Start a Home-Based Child Care Business?

Grant opportunities are available for income-eligible individuals in **Pike, Ross, Scioto, and Jackson** counties who want to start their own Type-B home-based child care business. Must be at or below 100% of the Federal Poverty Income Guideline (see reverse side for the Federal Poverty Income Guidelines).

Individuals completing the program are **eligible for grant dollars** for start-up and operation of the business.

To complete the program, participants are required to:

- Receive **Financial Literacy Training** provided by the Community Action Committee of Pike County
- Receive **Business Training** provided by the Community Action Committee of Pike County
- Receive **Family Child Care Training** from your local Job & Family Services
- Complete the process for **Child Care Certification** through your local Job & Family Services



Additional benefits and *free* technical assistance available for business start-up and operation.
