



Water Bill Assistance Program

This assistance is meant to help as many eligible customers as possible in a crisis situation. Households are eligible for a one time assistance through the program year, not to exceed the \$200 benefit amount.


Required Documentation

- ◆ Photo ID
- ◆ Income for the last 90 days (3mo.)
- ◆ Water bill



To be eligible for the program households must be at or below 125% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. Example: Income for a household of 4 needs to be at or below \$2,615.00 monthly. The Water must be in disconnect status or disconnected. The account must be in a household members name. Funds cannot be used for new service or deposits.

CAC of Pike County Community Service Block Grant

Water Bill Assistance Program

The Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA) has designated \$500,000 in Community Service Block Grant (CSBG) discretionary funds to provide emergency assistance toward eligible customer's water bills in 13 Ohio Counties. Pike County will receive \$25,858 to assist approximately 127 households.

- To be eligible, households must be at or below 125% of the federal poverty guidelines or categorically eligible (OWF or TANF) and have a water bill scheduled for disconnect or already disconnected.
- The maximum benefit a household can receive is \$200. It can be used to pay the bill, late fees, reconnect fees, or other items included on the bill that are required to maintain service for at least 30 days.
- The account must be in the name of an adult household member's name.
- Funds cannot be used for new service or deposits.

Household income must be at or below 125% of the 2019 Federal Poverty Guidelines:

<u>Size</u>	<u>Annual Income</u>
1 person:	up to \$15,613
2 people:	up to \$21,138
3 people:	up to \$26,663
4 people:	up to \$32,188
5 people:	up to \$37,713
6 people:	up to \$43,238
7 people:	up to \$48,763
8 people:	up to \$54,288

Add \$5,525 for each additional household member

Required Documentation:

- Photo ID
- Social security cards for all household members
- Income for the last 90 days or 12 months for all household members
- Current water bill
- Proof of co-pay (if applicable)
